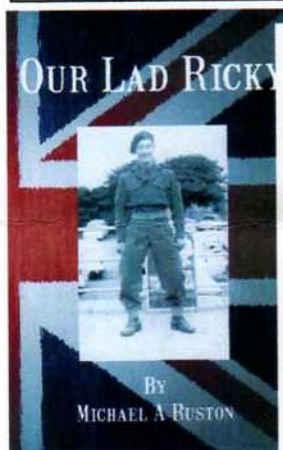


Ricky – The Early Years & Our Lad Ricky

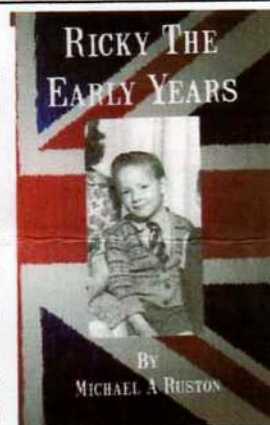
